TNT/UPS – Liege Airport’s position

Liege Airport, 14th January 2013 - Liege Airport notes the decision of TNT and UPS to cancel the merger. Although we must await the official decision of the European Commission, the failure of this merger reshuffles the cards on the integrators’ market.

Over the last six months, UPS has never given the Management of Liege Airport a clear account of their planned strategy for the Liege hub.

As concerns TNT Express, we shall contact them once the official decision of the European Commission is made known in order to clarify the new perspectives offered by this lone stance, particularly as regards the sales agreements of TNT Airways to ASL Aviation Group.
