

Logwin expands in Jakarta

Grevenmacher (Luxembourg) – The logistics services provider [Logwin](#) has further expanded its location in the Indonesian [capital of Jakarta](#) by moving into a modern, self-contained [warehouse](#) at Soekarno Hatta Airport in August.

A rarity among warehouses, the building is situated directly within the airport perimeter.

The new facility allows Logwin to increase its storage space from 280 square metres to 720 square metres. "We can offer our customers more space and modern equipment in the new warehouse," explains Eric Mathieu, Country Director of Logwin in Indonesia. "This enables us to meet the high demand and rising need for modern warehousing and transshipment space in Indonesia. In addition, our reliable logistics solutions enable us to offer efficient and safe access to one of the most attractive domestic markets in Asia."

Interim storage, customs clearance and onward transport

Logwin assumes responsibility for the transshipment of incoming [air freight](#) shipments that have to pass through customs on behalf of customers in the [consumer goods](#), [pharmaceuticals](#) and [food processing](#) industries. Customs processing generally takes between five and seven days. During this time imported goods are usually stored in public storage spaces at the airport where they are exposed to high temperatures, humidity, moisture and security risks.

This is where the Logwin warehouse offers decisive benefits. Arriving goods retain their customs seals until all formalities have been completed and the goods have been imported into Indonesia and released for onward transport. During this time the goods are stored in a secure, dry environment in a modern shelving system. The building is air-conditioned and equipped with refrigeration rooms, which guarantee storage at 5 degrees Celsius, so as to provide optimal conditions for good susceptible to temperature variations.

[Uniform IT standards](#) provide even greater security and transparency. "We can make seamless shipment information and communication available globally via the web from goods dispatch to delivery," says Eric

Mathieu. The Logwin warehouse is also equipped with an alarm system and is monitored by CCTV cameras around the clock.

Growth in Indonesia

Owing to its high level of domestic consumption and rising exports of industrial goods, Indonesia is one of the world's fastest and most steadily growing industrial nations. As in previous years, growth is once again expected to slightly exceed six percent in 2013. The island state's economy is also set to grow by 6.5 per cent in 2014.¹
