## **Cargojet Airways to operate freighter into Cologne**

As of April 25th Cargojet Airways operates a weekly B-767 freighter into Cologne. The flight connects Cologne Bonn Airport with Greater Moncton Airport in New Brunswick, Canada.

We are confident we will be able to sustain this freighter connection with sufficient uplift in both directions”, says Jacques Fournier, Director Cargo Development of Greater Moncton Airport.
