



## **AV Cargo Expand MD11F Fleet**

AV Cargo's additional MD11F has now joined the fleet, operating on a charter flight upon immediate release from maintenance and application of new livery. 'Hannah Mai' joined the fleet at the start of September and her inaugural flight in AV Cargo colours was between Hong Kong and Liege. The aircraft touched down at Liege Airport, AV Cargo's operational European hub, on Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup>. She will not be resting for long due to charter commitments later this week.

"We are delighted with the arrival of our new aircraft, especially given the contracted commitments that we have secured for 'Hannah Mai' to perform. We were always confident that the business model would be successful so it is pleasing to progress so far in a relatively short period of time", said Simon Clarke, CEO of AV Cargo.

The airline is now finalising plans for the future routes to ensure the optimal balance between charters and scheduled services is established. This will provide the market with reliable operations into West Africa as well as ad hoc uplift to global destinations.

The AV Cargo fleet of MD11Fs has a heavy payload of **94,000kg** each, providing a competitive alternative aircraft in the market. A further MD11F is planned for early 2014.

AV Cargo is now operating twice per week to Bamako, three times to Lagos to complement the services to Port Harcourt, Pointe Noire, Ouagadougou and Freetown. Over the next few weeks and months additional destinations will be further added.
