Faster cargo connections from and to the U.S. midwest as Virgin Atlantic Cargo takes off from Chicago

Customers across the US Midwest now have faster connections to Virgin Atlantic Cargo's network of over 350 destinations worldwide with the launch of new flights from Chicago.

The airline has introduced four Airbus A340-600 flights a week from Chicago, each offering up to 17,000 kilos of cargo capacity. Frequencies will increase to daily from May 18th.

Virgin Atlantic Cargo's fast and reliable trucking network in the United States means customers will enjoy quick connections to and from prime markets across the Midwest, including Cincinnati, Indianapolis, Milwaukee, Minneapolis St Paul, St Louis and Wayne Country.
