The methods which can be used are physical checks, x-ray, and trace-detection”, explains Wolfgang Korte, CEO, LUG aircargo handling GmbH.

Lug aircargo handling, one of the most innovative, independent ground service companies, has operated at Frankfurt/Main Airport for more than 40 years and is also one of the leading ground handlers in Munich.
