RCL deploys the biggest common feeder in Singapore - Thailand Service

Regional Container Lines (RCL) is pleased to announce the launch of their biggest feeder service on the Singapore-Laem Chabang- Singapore corridor.

The maiden voyage will commence ex Singapore on 18 July 2012 using APL Amman, a 3316 TEU vessel, in a weekly direct shuttle service linking Singapore (Wednesday/Thursday) and Laem Chabang (Sunday/Monday) - the biggest feeder runs in this corridor.

This is a significant milestone for RCL as it further upgrades wider feeder operations network coverage in Asia.

Mr Sumate Tanthuwant, President of Regional Container Lines highlighted that the enhanced service has demonstrated RCL's agility to adapt to changes and ability to cater for the demand of container line business.

Since the financial crisis in 2007, there have been substantial changes in the container business with more alliance/consortium agreements forming. RCL is in a very good position to continue leveraging on these developments with our two lines of business i.e. COC and SOC efficiently. Most importantly, we will continue to focus on our customers' needs and cater according to their changing business requirements

About RCL

Founded in 1979, RCL is a Thai based container shipping line. Listed on the Thai Stock Exchange since 1988, its core business is in the carriage of Shipper owned containers (SOC) and its own Carrier container containers (COC) in a service network that is fully Asia centric. RCL currently owns and operates a fleet of 40 vessels with sizes ranging between 500 TEUs to 3316 TEUs. It also has a fleet of 76,000 TEUs to support its own COC carriage as well.
