PSA VOLTRI PRA GEARS UP FOR THE FUTURE

On 10 June 2015, PSA Voltri Prà terminal in Italy placed orders for 4 gooseneck cranes with ZPMC in order to further upgrade its container terminal infrastructure.

This new order follows a previous order made at the end of 2014 for four similar cranes with the same supplier.

The first four cranes will arrive and be made operational in the first half of 2016 while the second set of cranes is expected to be delivered by the end of 2016.

These new cranes, which are slated to replace some of the older cranes currently in use, will have an outreach of 25 containers wide, enabling the Voltri Prà terminal to handle some of the biggest container vessels plying the oceans today.

With this new investment, PSA re-affirms its commitment to the port of Genoa and to developing the Voltri Prà terminal into the preferred hub for shipping lines serving the vast hinterland of southern continental Europe and beyond.
