Luxembourg, 18 February 2013. Cargolux today announced that is adding Port Harcourt in Nigeria as a new destination to its African network. The inaugural service, CV7122, will be operated on 5 March 2013 with Cargolux's Boeing 747 freighter.

Given the geo-political location, the oil and gas industry in the region increasingly demands more direct flights for its equipment and support-related items.
