Aer Lingus continues Trans Atlantic Expansion

Aer Lingus celebrated the launch of its inaugural light from Dublin to Toronto, its fourth transatlantic route launch in recent months and the latest part of its significant transatlantic growth plan in 2014 adding to the new San Francisco Dublin direct launched last month.

The new 757 service will operate with a daily service between Dublin and Toronto during the summer season and up to four weekly services operating during the winter. The new route also offers our customers additional connectivity by road to key cities within Canada.

Speaking on the occasion of the inaugural flight, Aer Lingus Director of Cargo Peter O'Neill said:

"We are delighted to add a direct service to Canada to our network. Toronto is a very important market in terms of business links. Aer Lingus has a long established supply route to Canada via Boston and New York. The service also opens up connections to all key cities within Canada by road freight. The 757 aircraft has opened up significant opportunities for Aer Lingus Cargo to and from Canada, especially for mail and small freight"
