



First Priority Cargo, (FPC) based in Dubai is pleased to announce the commencement of a new weekly Freighter Service ex Sharjah Airport (SHJ) into Eldoret (EDL) Kenya, from Monday 10th November.

Spearheading this move is Haksar Azad, General Manager of FPC, who has commented that despite the time taken to gain the necessary approvals from the Airport Authority & Government Officials, he is confident that the timing of this new service is perfect since it is coupled with the \$11.7m Eldoret Airport Expansion Program currently being rolled out.

FPC will then be perfectly placed to be able to expand the service to twice weekly to further benefit Kenyan Community and FPC partners.

Once goods are in Eldoret, FPC will be providing a Road Feeder Service into Nairobi where the goods can be Customs Cleared & delivered to the consignees.

FPC will be operating an A330 which is currently being chartered from Etihad Cargo, offering a capacity of 40 tons and is ideally suited to the mixed range of goods imported into this region. FPC is also not complacent and is also looking into utilizing the aircraft on the return leg from Eldoret to bring in fresh produce from Kenya which is very much in demand within the UAE & Middle East.
