IAG Cargo has today taken a significant step forward in its online strategy, making it possible for all customers to book services via the iagcargo.com web portal for the first time. Customers will be able to book online for IAG Cargo's Prioritise, Perform and Constant Fresh services, with e-booking extended to additional IAG Cargo services later in the year. The addition of e-booking to the site provides customers with faster confirmation of bookings and 24/7 availability.
